


4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 437, Government Code, is  
6 amended by adding Section 437.063 to read as follows:


7 Sec. 437.063. ADJUTANT GENERAL: DELEGATION OF EXPENDITURE  
8 APPROVAL AUTHORITY. The adjutant general may delegate the authority  
9 to approve department expenditures to the executive director.

10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.




