5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this
7	Act, the directors of the Angelina County Water Control and
8	Improvement District No. 3 shall wind up the affairs of the
9	district.
10	(b) On the 30th day after the effective date of this Act:
11	(1) the Angelina County Water Control and Improvement
12	District No. 3 is dissolved;
13	(2) the terms of the directors of the district expire;
14	and
15	(3) all assets and liabilities of the district are
16	transferred to the Angelina County Fresh Water Supply District No.
17	1.
18	SECTION 2. Subtitle B, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
19	Code, is amended by adding Chapter 6918 to read as follows:
20	CHAPTER 6918. ANGELINA COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 1;
21	TERRITORY
22	Sec. 6918.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "district"
23	means the Angelina County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1.

Sec. 6918.002. ADDITIONAL TERRITORY. On the effective date

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- 1 of the Act enacting this chapter, the territory of the former
- 2 Angelina County Water Control and Improvement District No. 3, as
- 3 that territory existed on April 1, 2017, is added to the territory
- 4 of the district.
- 5 SECTION 3. Before the 30th day after the effective date of
- 6 this Act, the board of directors of the Angelina County Water
- 7 Control and Improvement District No. 3 may select from the members
- 8 serving on the board on the date of the selection one member to
- 9 serve as a nonvoting member of the board of the Angelina County
- 10 Fresh Water Supply District No. 1 from the date of the selection
- 11 until the next election of directors for the Angelina County Fresh
- 12 Water Supply District No. 1.
- 13 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 14 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 15 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 16 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 17 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 18 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 19 Government Code.
- 20 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 21 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 22 Environmental Quality.
- (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 24 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 25 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 26 representatives within the required time.
- 27 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this


