H.B. No. 3283

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 16 in
3 Duval County as the Al Dean Memorial Highway.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
6 is amended by adding Section 225.123 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 225.123. AL DEAN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of
8 State Highway 16 in Duval County between the northern municipal
9 boundary of Freer and the southern boundary of McMullen County is
10 designated as the Al Dean Memorial Highway. The designation is in
11 addition to any other designation.

12 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

13 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
14 highway number, the designation as the Al Dean Memorial Highway,
15 and any other appropriate information; and

16 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
17 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
22 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

IN RE: HB3283 by Guillen (Relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 16 in Duval County as the Al Dean Memorial Highway.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to design, construct, and erect highway markers designating a portion of State Highway 16 as the Al Dean Memorial Highway, subject to Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code.

Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code, specifies that TxDOT may not design, construct, or erect the marker unless a grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the cost.
