14 <u>(2) coordinate with other federal, state, and local</u> 15 jurisdictions and officials [funding and coordination with other 16 federal, state, and local jurisdictions and officials in matters 17 relating to the operations of the Texas military forces occurring 18 in the assistant deputy adjutant general's jurisdiction or 19 oversight].

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.


