

IN RE: SB588 by Lucio (Relating to information regarding private employers who have veteran's employment preference policies.), As Introduced

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

This bill would amend the Government Code and the Labor Code relating to information regarding private employers who have veteran's employment preference policies.
