S.B. No. 881

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the board of directors of the Maverick County Hospital
3 District.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 1118.054, Special District Local Laws
6 Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection
7 (c) to read as follows:

8 (a) If a vacancy occurs in the office of director, the
9 remaining directors by majority [~~a-unanimous~~] vote shall appoint a
10 director for the unexpired term.

11 (c) If the number of directors is reduced to fewer than
12 three for any reason, the remaining directors shall immediately
13 call a special election to fill the vacancies. If the remaining
14 directors do not call the election, a district court, on
15 application of a district voter or taxpayer, may order the
16 directors to hold the election.

17 SECTION 2. Section 1118.055, Special District Local Laws
18 Code, is amended to read as follows:

19 Sec. 1118.055. OFFICERS. The board shall elect from among
20 its members a chairman, a vice-chairman, [~~president,~~] a secretary,
21 and a treasurer at the first meeting after each directors'
22 election.

23 SECTION 3. Section 1118.207(a), Special District Local Laws
24 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1 (a) The board chairman [~~president~~] shall execute the
2 district's bonds in the district's name.

3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017._____
