4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 1601, Occupations Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 1601.0025 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 1601.0025. SERVICES NOT CONSTITUTING BARBERING.
7	Notwithstanding Section 1601.002, "barbering," "practicing
8	barbering," and "practice of barbering" do not include threading,
9	which involves removing unwanted hair from a person by using a piece
10	of thread that is looped around the hair and pulled to remove the
11	hair and includes the incidental trimming of eyebrow hair.
12	SECTION 2. Section 1602.002(a), Occupations Code, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	(a) In this chapter, "cosmetology" means the practice of
15	performing or offering to perform for compensation any of the
16	following services:
17	(1) treating a person's hair by:
18	(A) providing any method of treatment as a
19	primary service, including arranging, beautifying, bleaching,
20	cleansing, coloring, cutting, dressing, dyeing, processing,
21	shampooing, shaping, singeing, straightening, styling, tinting, or
22	waving;
23	(B) providing a necessary service that is
24	preparatory or ancillary to a service under Paragraph (A),
