- 13 commissioners court, or any two of any number of persons delegated
- 14 by the commission with authority to sign vouchers, provided that
- 15 the commission may, in such delegation, limit the authority of such
- 16 persons and may require that each furnish a fidelity bond in such
- 17 amount as the commission shall specify and subject to commission
- 18 approval;
- 19 (3) carefully preserve all orders for the payment of
- 20 money; and
- 21 (4) render a correct account to the commissioners
- 22 court of all matters relating to the financial condition of the
