## TEXAS

Eggs set for the week ending November 10, 1979, was 255,000, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This was down 10 percent from the same week last year but 2 percent above last week.

Poults hatched totaled 127,000 during the week ending November 10. This was 31 percent above a year ago, but 2 percent below the previous week.

Thus far this season, 1,244,000 poults have been hatched, 46 percent above the same period last year.

## NINE STATES

The nine states in the weekly program reported a total of 3,036,000 eggs set, 22 percent above last year and 6 percent above a week ago.

Poults hatched during the week totaled 1,648,000, 23 percent above last year, and 3 percent above last week.

Thus far this season, 17,715,000 poults have been hatched, 33 percent above the corresponding period last year.
