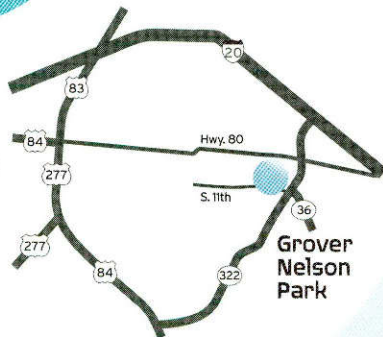
## Abilene's Grover Nelson Park Small Pond

Adults need a current fishing license with freshwater stamp to fish at Neighborhood Fishin' lakes. Kids under 17 do not need a fishing license. ## What's Biting?

#### Channel catfish

Stocked every two weeks, from the third week in April through early November (except during August)



#### Rainbow trout

Stocked every two weeks, from late November or early December until March
