# TEXAS

Heavy breed poults hatched for the week ending June 23, 1979, was 165,000, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This is 44 percent less than a year ago, and 27 percent below a week ago.

Eggs set during the week totaled 358,000, down 7 percent from a year ago, and 13 percent below last week.

So far this season, 7,589,000 poults have been hatched, 4 percent above the same period last year.

# NINE STATES

The nine states in the weekly program reported a total of 3,531,000 poults hatched, up 3 percent from last year, but 5 percent below a week ago.

Eggs set during the week, at 4,745,000, were 6 percent above last year, but 5 percent less than the previous week.

Thus far this season, 109,129,000 poults have been hatched, 14 percent above the corresponding period last year.

## TURKEYS TESTED - BY OFFICIAL STATE AGENCIES

#### TEXAS

There were 31,700 heavy breed turkeys tested for pullorum-typhoid disease in May 1979, over  $2\frac{1}{2}$  times as many as a year ago.

For the first eleven months of the 1978-79 season, 311,434 birds were tested, compared with 266,556 a year ago.

#### UNITED STATES

Testings of heavy breed turkeys during May totaled 181,905, 58 percent above 1978. Light breeds tested totaled 11,155, compared with 8,879 the same month last year.

Thus far this season, 2,756,086 heavy breeds and 144,730 light breeds have been tested.
