

#### TEXAS

Total poults hatched for the week ending February 2, 1980, was 211,000, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This was 14 percent above a year ago, but 1 percent below last week.

Eggs set for poult production was 347,000. This was up 10 percent from the same week last year but 7 percent below the previous week.

Thus far this season, 3,608,000 poults have been hatched, 22 percent above the same period last year.

#### NINE STATES

The nine states in the weekly program reported a total of 2,801,000 poults hatched, 11 percent above last year, but 2 percent below a week ago.

Eggs set during the week, at 4,568,000 were 4 percent above last year, and 5 percent above last week.

Thus far this season, 45,393,000 poults have been hatched, 22 percent above the corresponding period last year.

## TURKEYS TESTED - BY OFFICIAL STATE AGENCIES

#### TEXAS

There were 49,011 heavy breed turkeys tested for pullorum-typhoid disease in December 1979, up 39 percent from a year ago.

For the 1978-79 season, 276,278 birds were tested, compared with 195,951 a year ago.

### UNITED STATES

Testings of heavy breed turkeys during December totaled 390,359, up 3 percent from 1978. Light breeds tested totaled 10,413, compared with 16,861 the same month last year.

Thus far this season, 2,064,027 heavy breeds and 91,133 light breeds have been tested.
