# TEXAS

Poults hatched for the week ending September 19, 1981, totaled 135,000, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This was 265 percent above a year ago and 19 percent above last week. Eggs set for poult production are confidential to avoid disclosing individual operations.

## NINE STATES

The nine states in the weekly program reported a total of 1,672,000 poults hatched, 5 percent above last year, and 15 percent above last week. Eggs set during the week totaled
2,320,000, 7 percent below last year, but 12 percent above a week ago.

### Turkey Breeder Hen Intentions Down 9 Percent

Texas flock operators indicated they would hold 463,000 breeder hens on December 1, 1981, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This is 9 percent below 1980's 510,000 birds, and 13 percent lower than 1979's 533,000. Heavy breeds accounted for 100 percent of the expected December 1 inventory. Turkey breeder hen intentions of 3.67 million for December 1, 1981 indicated a decline of 5 percent from a year earlier by flock owners in 26 selected States. Heavy breed flocks are expected to decline to 3.52 million hens or 3 percent less than the 3.61 million hens in 1980. Light breed flocks are expected to decline to 154 thousand hens, 42 percent below the 264 thousand light breed hens recorded for December 1, 1980.
