

Texas Turkey Poults



For week ending December 20, 1980 Released: December 29, 1980

TEXAS

Eggs set for the week ending December 20, 1980, totaled 259,000, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This was 14 percent below a year ago but 31 percent above the previous week. Poults hatched totaled 166,000 during the week ending December 20. This was 28 percent below a year ago.

NINE STATES

The nine states in the weekly program reported a total of 3,678,000 eggs set, 11 percent below last year and 3 percent below a week ago. Poults hatched during the week totaled 2,330,000 down 6 percent from last year but 8 percent above last week.

Thus far this season, 29,021,000 poults have been hatchethyennercent above the corresponding period last year.

TURKEYS TESTED - BY OFFICIAL STATE AGENCIES

TEXAS

There were 22,900 heavy breed turkeys tested for pullorum-typhoid disease in November 1980, 52 percent below last year.

For the 1980-1981 season, 103,509 birds were tested, compared with 227,267 a year ago.

UNITED STATES

Testings of heavy breed turkeys during November totaled 327,070, down 20 percent from 1979. Light breeds tested totaled 17,064 compared with 19,800 the same month last year.

Thus far this season, 1,431,741 heavy breeds and 86,501 light breeds have been tested.
