## EGG-TYPE CHICKS BELOW 1979

The number of egg-type chicks hatched in April was 1.5 million, down 50 percent from last year, but up 13 percent from last month, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Serice.

## BROILER CHICKS UP 10 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

There were 22.8 million broiler chicks hatched, 10 percent above a year ago, but 1 percent below the previous month.

# TURKEY POULTS DOWN 7 PERCENT FROM 1979

Turkey poults hatched at 1,008,000 were 7 percent below 1979, and 15 percent less than March 1980.

#### EGG PRODUCTION ABOVE A YEAR AGO

There were 244 million eggs produced in April, up 3 percent from April 1979. The 12.4 million layers had an average rate of lay of 65.7 percent. Layers on hand were 4 percent above a year ago, and 1 percent more than last month.

## EGG-FEED PRICE RATIO

This month's egg-feed price ratio of 6.0 was 25 percent below last year and 12 percent below last month.

#### MARCH 1980 POULTRY SLAUGHTER

Slaughter of all chickens during March was slightly below last year, but 11 percent more than February. Turkey slaughter was 54 percent above last month.

#### UNITED STATES

#### EGG-TYPE AND BROILER CHICKS

The egg-type hatch of 46.6 million was 11 percent below last year, but 2 percent more than last month. Broilers hatched, at 371.9 million was down 1 percent from 1979, and 2 percent less than last month.

## TURKEY POULTS

Heavy breed poults hatched totaled 19.6 million and light breeds totaled 1.4 million. The combined sum of 21.0 million was slightly below last year but 3 percent above last month.

## LAYERS AND EGG PRODUCTION

Eggs produced numbered 5.7 billion, slightly below last year, and down 4 percent from last month. The average rate of lay was 67.3 percent, up 1 percent from last year. The United States laying flock totaled 282 million, 2 percent below a year earlier and down 1 percent from March.

## EGG-FEED PRICE RATIO

Egg-feed price ratio of 6.0 was 19 percent less than last year and 5 percent below last month.

## POULTRY SLAUGHTER

Chickens slaughtered during March were down 2 percent from a year ago, but 3 percent above the previous month, while turkey slaughter was 32 percent above a year ago, and 18 percent more than February.
