TEXAS

EGG-TYPE CHICKS BELOW 1979

The number of egg-type chicks hatched in March was 1.3 million, down 55 percent from last year, but up 2 percent from last month, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service.

BROILER CHICKS UP 15 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

There were 23.0 million broiler chicks hatched, 15 percent above a year ago, and 8 percent above the previous month.

TURKEY POULTS UP 14 PERCENT FROM 1979

Turkey poults hatched at 1,188,000 were 14 percent above 1979, and 27 percent more than February 1980.

EGG PRODUCTION ABOVE A YEAR AGO

There were 247 million eggs produced in March, up 5 percent from March 1979. The 12.2 million layers had an average rate of lay of 65.3 percent. Layers on hand were 3 percent above a year ago, but slightly less than last month.

EGG-FEED PRICE RATIO

This month's egg-feed price ratio of 6.8 was 17 percent below last year and 6 percent below last month.

FEBRUARY 1980 POULTRY SLAUGHTER

Slaughter of all chickens during February was 3 percent above last year, but 13 percent less than January. Turkey slaughter was 29 percent below last month.

UNITED STATES

EGG-TYPE AND BROILER CHICKS

The egg-type hatch of 45.9 million was 9 percent below last year, but 9 percent more than last month. Broilers hatched, at 381.5 million was up 3 percent from 1979, and 10 percent above last month.

TURKEY POULTS

Heavy breed poults hatched totaled 18.9 million and light breeds totaled 1.4 million. The combined sum of 20.3 million was 1 percent above last year and 24 percent above last month.

LAYERS AND EGG PRODUCTION

Eggs produced numbered 5.9 billion, up 1 percent from last year, and up 6 percent from last month. The average rate of lay was 67.6 percent, up 3 percent from last year. The United States laying flock totaled 286 million, 1 percent below both a year earlier and February of this year.

EGG-FEED PRICE RATIO

Egg-feed price ratio of 6.3 was 20 percent less than last year but 7 percent above last month.

POULTRY SLAUGHTER

Chickens slaughtered during February were up 15 percent from a year ago, but 8 percent below the previous month, while turkey slaughter was 43 percent above a year ago, but 16 percent less than January.
