

Texas Department of Agriculture Reagan V. Brown, Commissioner For week ending February 23, 1980 Released: February 28, 1980

TEXAS

Total poults hatched for the week ending February 23, 1980, was 252,000, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This was 19 percent above a year ago and 4 percent above last week.

Eggs set for poult production was 374,000. This was up 17 percent from the same week last year and 3 percent above the previous

Thus far this season, 4,278,000 poults have been hatched, 20 percent above the same period last year.

NINE STATES

The nine states in the weekly program reported a total of 3,082,000 poults hatched, 1 percent below last year but 3 percent above a week ago.

Eggs set during the week, at 5,167,000, were slightly above last year and 5 percent above last week.

Thus far this season, 54,384,000 poults have been hatched, 18 percent above the corresponing period last year.

TURKEYS TESTED - BY OFFICIAL STATE AGENCIES

TEXAS

There were no heavy breed turkeys tested for pullorum-typhoid disease in January 1980.

For the 1979-1980 season, 276,278 birds were tested, compared with 260,046 a year ago.

UNITED STATES

Testings of heavy breed turkeys during January totaled 201,165, down 16 percent from 1979. Light breeds tested totaled 9,365, compared with 1,234 the same month last year.

Thus far this season, 2,265,192 heavy breeds and 100,498 light breeds have been tested.
