TEXAS

Eggs set for the week ending October 27, 1979, was 258,000, according to the Texas Crop and Livestock Reporting Service. This was up 26 percent from the same week last year and the same as the previous week.

Poults hatched totaled 97,000 during the week ending October 27. This was 5 percent below a year ago, but 4 percent above the previous week.

Thus far this season, 987,000 poults have been hatched, 49 percent above the same period last year.

NINE STATES

The nine states in the weekly program reported a total of 2,253,000 eggs set, 10 percent above last year but 4 percent below a week ago.

Poults hatched during the week totaled 1,692,000, 28 percent above last year, but 1 percent below last week.

Thus far this season, 14,458,000 poults have been hatched, 36 percent above the corresponding period last year.
