4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1451, Insurance Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 1451.1261 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1451.1261. REIMBURSEMENT FOR CERTAIN SERVICES AND
8	PROCEDURES PERFORMED BY PHARMACISTS. (a) Notwithstanding any
9	other law, in addition to applying to a policy, agreement, or
10	contract described by Section 1451.102, this section applies to any
11	other individual or group health benefit plan that provides
12	benefits described by Section 1451.102, including:
13	(1) a health benefit plan issued by:
14	(A) a group hospital service corporation
15	operating under Chapter 842;
16	(B) a health maintenance organization operating
17	under Chapter 843; or
18	(C) a multiple employer welfare arrangement that
19	holds a certificate of authority under Chapter 846;
20	(2) a small employer health benefit plan subject to
21	Chapter 1501;
22	(3) a standard health benefit plan issued under
23	Chapter 1507;
24	(4) <u>health benefits provided by or through</u> a church

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benefits board under Subchapter I, Chapter 22, Business 1 2 Organizations Code; 3 (5) a regional or local health care program operated under Section 75.104, Health and Safety Code; and 4 5 (6) a self-funded health benefit plan sponsored by a professional employer organization under Chapter 91, Labor Code. 6 7 (b) This section does not apply to: (1) a basic coverage plan under Chapter 1551; 8 (2) a basic plan under Chapter 1575; 9 10 (3) a primary care coverage plan under Chapter 1579; (4) a plan providing basic coverage under Chapter 11 12 1601; (5) the state Medicaid program, including the Medicaid 13 managed care program operated under Chapter 533, Government Code; 14 15 or (6) the child health plan program under Chapter 62, 16 17 Health and Safety Code. 18 (c) Notwithstanding Section 1451.102, this section applies 19 to coverage under a group health benefit plan provided to a resident 20 of this state regardless of whether the group policy, agreement, or contract is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed in this 21 22 state. (d) An insurer or other health benefit plan issuer or a 23 24 third-party administrator or pharmacy benefit manager of a health 25 benefit plan may not deny reimbursement to a pharmacist for the provision of a service or procedure within the scope of the 26 27 pharmacist's license to practice pharmacy under Subtitle J, Title

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1 3, Occupations Code, that:

2	(1) would be covered by the insurance policy or other
3	coverage agreement if the service or procedure were provided by:
4	(A) a physician;
5	(B) an advanced practice nurse; or
6	(C) a physician assistant; and
7	(2) is performed by the pharmacist in strict
8	compliance with laws and rules related to:
9	(A) the provision of the service or procedure;
10	and
11	(B) the pharmacist's license.
12	(e) This section may not be construed to require an insurer
13	or other health benefit plan issuer or a third-party administrator
14	or pharmacy benefit manager to reimburse a pharmacist or pharmacy
15	<u>as an in-network or preferred provider.</u>
16	SECTION 2. Section 1451.1261, Insurance Code, as added by
17	this Act, applies only to a health benefit plan that is delivered,
18	issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2020. A plan
19	delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2020,
20	is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the
21	effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for
22	that purpose.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
