## Chapter 96

1	AN ACT
2	relating to extensions of an expired permit for the transfer of
3	groundwater from a groundwater conservation district.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 36.122, Water Code, is amended by adding
6	Subsections $(j-1)$ , $(j-2)$ , $(r)$ , and $(s)$ and amending Subsection $(k)$
7	to read as follows:
8	(j-1) A district shall extend a term under Subsection (i)(2)
9	or (j) on or before its expiration in the manner prescribed by
10	Section 36.1145:
11	(1) to a term that is not shorter than the term of an
12	operating permit for the production of water to be transferred that
13	is in effect at the time of the extension; and
14	(2) for each additional term for which that operating
15	permit for production is renewed under Section 36.1145 or remains
16	in effect under Section 36.1146.
17	(j-2) A permit extended under Subsection (j-1) continues to
18	be subject to conditions contained in the permit as issued before
19	the extension.
20	(k) Notwithstanding the period specified <u>under Subsection</u>
21	[ <del>in Subsections</del> ] (i) <u>,</u> [ <del>and</del> ] (j) <u>, or (j-1)</u> during which water may be
22	transferred under a permit, a district may periodically review the
23	amount of water that may be transferred under the permit and may
24	limit the amount if additional factors considered in Subsection (f)

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warrant the limitation, subject to Subsection (c). The review 1 described by this subsection may take place not more frequently 2 than the period provided for the review or renewal of regular 3 permits issued by the district. In its determination of whether to 4 renew a permit issued under this section, the district shall 5 consider relevant and current data for the conservation of 6 groundwater resources and shall consider the permit in the same 7 manner it would consider any other permit in the district. 8

9 <u>(r) The district may grant or deny an application to extend</u> 10 <u>a term under Subsection (i)(2) or (j) submitted under this section</u> 11 <u>only using rules that were in effect at the time the application was</u> 12 <u>submitted.</u>

13 (s) An application to extend a term under Subsection (i)(2)
14 or (j) is governed solely by district rules consistent with
15 Subsection (j-1).

16 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 17 the term of a permit issued under Sections 36.122(i) and (j), Water 18 Code, that expires after September 1, 2019.

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
