


2 SECTION 3. The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board is
3 required to implement a provision of this Act only if the
4 legislature appropriates money specifically for that purpose. If
5 the legislature does not appropriate money specifically for that
6 purpose, the coordinating board may, but is not required to,
7 implement a provision of this Act using other appropriations
8 available for that purpose.

9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.






