18	(2) has a value of \$100,000 or more that is to be paid
19	wholly or partly from public funds of the governmental entity.
20	(b) A governmental entity may not enter into a contract with
21	a company for goods or services unless the contract contains a
22	written verification from the company that it:
23	(1) does not boycott Israel; and
24	(2) will not boycott Israel during the term of the

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
