10	obtained by a flood control district located in a county with a
11	population of 3.3 million or more in connection with operations
12	related to a declared disaster or flooding is excepted from the
13	requirements of Section 552.021:
14	<pre>(1) a person's name;</pre>
15	(2) a home address;
16	<pre>(3) a business address;</pre>
17	(4) a home telephone number;
18	(5) a mobile telephone number;
19	(6) an electronic mail address;
20	(7) social media account information; and
21	(8) a social security number.
22	SECTION 2. Section 552.159, Government Code, as added by
23	this Act, applies only to a request for public information received
24	on or after the effective date of this Act. A request received
