6	SECTION 1. Section 623.219, Transportation Code, is amended
7	by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
8	(b-1) For a permit issued by a port authority contiguous to
9	the Gulf of Mexico or a bay or inlet opening into the gulf with a
10	population of not more than 200,000 that is adjacent to a county
11	described in Subsection (b), the commission shall, with the consent
12	of the port authority, designate the most direct route from:
13	(1) the Matagorda County line to the entrance of the
14	Port of Palacios using State Highway 35;
15	(2) the Matagorda County line to the entrance of the
16	Port of Palacios using State Highway 60;
17	(3) the Matagorda County line to the entrance of the
18	Port of Palacios using FM 521; and
19	(4) the Matagorda County line to the entrance of the
20	Port of Palacios using State Highway 71.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
