- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 51, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 51.609 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 51.609. UNCOLLECTIBLE FEES. (a) The clerk may request
- 8 the court in which a court cost or fee was imposed on a party in a
- 9 civil case to make a finding that the cost or fee is uncollectible
- 10 if the cost or fee has been unpaid for at least 15 years.
- 11 (b) On a finding by a court that a court cost or fee imposed
- on a party in a civil case is uncollectible, the court may order the
- 13 clerk to designate the cost or fee as uncollectible in the fee
- 14 record. The clerk shall attach a copy of the court's order to the
- 15 fee record.
- (c) This section does not apply to a court cost or fee
- 17 imposed by the supreme court, the court of criminal appeals, or a
- 18 court of appeals.
- 19 SECTION 2. Article 103.0081(c), Code of Criminal Procedure,
- 20 is repealed.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
