H.B. No. 468

1 AN ACT
2 relating to the authority of the Collingsworth County Hospital
3 District to take certain actions regarding district property.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 1014.107, Special District Local Laws
6 Code, is amended to read as follows:

7 Sec. 1014.107. DISTRICT PROPERTY, FACILITIES, AND
8 EQUIPMENT [~~BUILDINGS~~]. (a) The board shall determine:

9 (1) the type, number, and location of buildings or
10 other facilities required to maintain an adequate hospital system;
11 and

12 (2) the type of equipment necessary for hospital care.

13 (b) The board may:

14 (1) acquire by purchase, lease, or lease to purchase
15 or may construct, repair, or renovate property, including
16 facilities or equipment, for use in the district's hospital system;
17 and

18 (2) mortgage or pledge the property as security for
19 the purchase price.

20 (c) The board may lease, sell, or otherwise dispose of all
21 or part of the district's property for the district, including
22 facilities or equipment, to a public or private entity.


23 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 1014, Special District
24 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 1014.113 to read as

1 follows:


2 Sec. 1014.113. OPERATING AND MANAGEMENT CONTRACTS.
3 Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the district,
4 through its board, may contract with any person to manage or operate
5 a district facility.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
10 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
