

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of certain county assistance districts to
3 provide a grant or loan.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 387.006(a), Local Government Code, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) A district may:

8 (1) perform any act necessary to the full exercise of
9 the district's functions;

10 (2) accept a grant or loan from:

11 (A) the United States;

12 (B) an agency or political subdivision of this
13 state; or

14 (C) a public or private person;

15 (3) acquire, sell, lease, convey, or otherwise dispose
16 of property or an interest in property under terms determined by the
17 district;

18 (4) employ necessary personnel;


19 (5) adopt rules to govern the operation of the
20 district and its employees and property; ~~and~~

21 (6) enter into agreements with municipalities
22 necessary or convenient to achieve the district's purposes,
23 including agreements regarding the duration, rate, and allocation
24 between the district and the municipality of sales and use taxes;



2 (7) if the district is created by a county with a
3 population of more than 580,000 that borders a county with a
4 population of more than four million, provide a grant or loan to a
5 political subdivision to assist in funding the performance of one
6 or more functions a district is authorized to perform under this
7 chapter.

8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.



PROCLAMATION
BY THE
Governor of the State of Texas

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 14, of the Texas Constitution, I, Greg Abbott, Governor of Texas, do hereby disapprove of and veto House Bill No. 1174 as passed by the Eighty-Sixth Texas Legislature, Regular Session, because of the following objections:

House Bill 1174 would allow county assistance districts to give their financial resources to other political subdivisions, but would do so without protecting against abuse.

Since the Eighty-Sixth Texas Legislature, Regular Session, by its adjournment has prevented the return of this bill, I am filing these objections in the office of the Secretary of State and giving notice thereof by this public proclamation according to the aforementioned constitutional provision.
