5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 304.151, Business & Commerce Code, is
7	amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to
8	read as follows:
9	(b) A telemarketer may not:
10	(1) interfere with or circumvent the capability of a
11	caller identification service or device to access or provide to the
12	recipient of the telemarketing call any information regarding the
13	call that the service or device is capable of providing; [ <del>or</del> ]
14	(2) fail to provide caller identification information
15	in a manner that is accessible by a caller identification service or
16	device, if the telemarketer is capable of providing the information
17	in that manner <u>; or</u>
18	(3) cause misleading information to be transmitted to
19	a recipient's caller identification service or device or to
20	otherwise misrepresent the origin of a telemarketing call.
21	(c) A telemarketer does not violate Subsection (b)(3) if the
22	telemarketer substitutes the name and telephone number of the
23	person on whose behalf the call is made for the telemarketer's name
24	and telephone number.
