6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Section 51.882, Education Code, is amended by

8 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (f) to read as

9 follows:

10 (d) Each institution of higher education that adopts a

11 policy under Subsection (a):

12 (1) must require that the institution's campuses have

13 personnel or volunteers authorized and trained to administer an

14 epinephrine auto-injector present; and

15 (2) shall include the policy in the institution's

16 student handbook or similar publication and publish the policy on

17 the institution's Internet website.

(f) An institution of higher education that adopts a policy

19 under Subsection (a) shall submit to the Department of State Health

20 Services a copy of the policy and any amendment to the policy

21 adopted by the institution. The department shall maintain a record

22 of the most recent policy and amendments submitted by each

23 <u>institution under this subsection and shall make that information</u>

24 available to the public on request.

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
