

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The valiant military service of Charles Chris
2 Hagemeister is being saluted as part of the 2019 Medal of Honor Host
3 City Weekend in Gainesville; and

4 WHEREAS, Established in 2001, Gainesville's Medal of Honor
5 Host City Program acknowledges the heroism and sacrifice of
6 individuals who have earned the Medal of Honor, the nation's
7 highest military award for valor; each year, local citizens join
8 together to fund travel costs and other expenses to bring medal
9 recipients to the city for a special series of events; and

10 WHEREAS, A veteran of the U.S. Army, Charles Hagemeister
11 served during the Vietnam War as a specialist fourth class with the
12 1st Cavalry Division; his platoon came under heavy attack during
13 combat operations, and he raced through a hail of enemy fire to
14 render lifesaving medical aid to his wounded comrades; threatened
15 by sniper attack while trying to evacuate his fellow fighters, he
16 returned fire, killing four enemy soldiers and then once more
17 braving a barrage of bullets as he sought help from a nearby
18 platoon; repeatedly risking his own life in the process, he carried
19 many comrades to safety; and


20 WHEREAS, Demonstrating extraordinary courage in the line of






