4	SECTION 1. Section 372.053, Transportation Code, is amended
5	by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2)
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) A toll project entity may establish a discount program
8	for electronic toll collection customers.
9	(a-1) A [The] program established under Subsection (a) must
10	include free or discounted use of the entity's toll project by an
11	electronic toll collection customer whose account relates to a
12	vehicle registered under Section 504.202 or 504.315(f) or (g).
13	(a-2) A toll project entity may limit to no more than two the
14	number of transponders issued to a participant in the entity's
15	waiver program for which free or discounted use of the entity's toll
16	project is provided under Subsection (a-1). A toll project entity
17	that adopts a limit under this subsection shall allow a participant
18	to be issued one extra transponder on a demonstration of hardship by
19	the participant, as determined by the entity.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
