| 6 | SECTION 1. Section 28.004(c), Education Code, is amended to |

| 23 | (F) school health services; |
| 24 | (G) counseling and guidance services; |
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| 1 | (H) a safe and healthy school environment; and |
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| 2 | (I) school employee wellness; |
| 3 | (3) appropriate grade levels and methods of |
| 4 | instruction for human sexuality instruction; |
| 5 | (4) strategies for integrating the curriculum |
| 6 | components specified by Subdivision (2) with the following elements |
| 7 | in a coordinated school health program for the district: |
| 8 | (A) school health services; |
| 9 | (B) counseling and guidance services; |
| 10 | (C) a safe and healthy school environment; and |

| 12 | (5) if feasible, joint use agreements or strategies |

| 19 | SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives |
| 20 | a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as |
| 21 | provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this |
| 22 | Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this |
| 23 | Act takes effect September 1, 2019. |
