All-terrain Vehicle Validation Sticker (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-3e, Section 6a). One validation sticker (no license plate) issued annually to owners of three and four-wheel ATVs who wish to operate their vehicles off-highway on public property. Fee $-\$ 6.30$. Dimensions: $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ in diameter.

Amateur Radio Operator (V.A.T.S., Article 6701c-2). Two plates issued to holders of FCC mobile amateur radio station license who regularly operate receiving and transmitting radio equipment in a passenger car or light truck. Initial application and a $\$ 2.00$ fee must be submitted to Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Regular fee charged according to classification.


Antique(V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5a). Two plates issued for a five-year period, or remainder thereof, for passenger cars and trucks attaining the age of 25 years. The vehicle must be used for exhibitions, club activities, parades, and other functions of public interest and in no case for regular transportation. Applications must be filed with the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. The fee for the five-year period is: vehicles manufactured in 1921 and subsequent years $\$ 50.30$; vehicles manufactured in 1920 and prior years - $\$ 40.30$.

Antique Validation Sticker (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5a). One sticker issued annually for display on old Texas license plates that were originally issued the same year as the model year of the antique vehicle. Fee same as antique plate. Dimensions: $1^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ ".

Apportioned (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-16). One plate issued annually to Texas-based commercial power units and/or trailer vehicles that operate interstate into states with which license fees have been apportioned or prorated. Plate issued for power unit must be displayed on the front of the vehicle. Two numbers, one letter " $R$ " followed by three numbers on trailer plates - " R " followed by four or five letters on truck tractor plates. These plates must be secured from the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Fee is $\$ 2.00$ plus registration fees.

Armed Forces Reserve (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5e.3). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles owned by members of the U.S. Armed Forces Reserve. No other fee than the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

City Bus (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5[b]). Two plates issued. Prefix of the letter " $T$ " followed by five numbers. Fee same as passenger car.

Classic Auto/Truck (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5n). Two plates issued to passenger cars (Classic Auto) and light commercial vehicles (Classic Truck) which are 25 or more years old. Fee is $\$ 15.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Classic Auto/Truck Windshield Validation Sticker (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5n). One set of stickers issued (year sticker issued annually) for display on the vehicle's windshield when old Texas license plates match the same year model and classification of the vehicle. Qualifications and fee are the same as for the Classic License Plate. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Dimensions: year sticker $-1^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$, month sticker - 1-3/4" $\times 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Coast Guard Auxiliary (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to members of the Coast Guard Auxiliary. Fee is $\$ 10.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Collegiate (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5j). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles displaying the name and insignia of various participating Texas colleges and universities. Fee is $\$ 30.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and special plate fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Cotton Vehicle (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5o). One plate issued to vehicles used only in the cultivation, harvesting, and transportation of cotton. Fee is a one-time $\$ 8.00$ charge in addition to the regular registration fee, which is collected annually.

Dealer (V.A.T.S., Article 6686). Annual license plate. Fee for dealer's general distinguishing number: New entry $-\$ 250$, Renewal $-\$ 100$. Separate general distinguishing numbers are issued for the sale of motor vehicles, motorcycles, travel trailers, or trailers and semitrailers. Once a general distinguishing number is obtained, the dealer may purchase a metal dealer license plate and have buyer's cardboard tags (red numbers) and temporary cardboard tags (black numbers) printed. Fee per metal plate - $\$ 10.30$ plus $\$ 25$ use tax.

Desert Storm (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to members of the U.S. Armed Forces who took part in Operation Desert Shield/Storm. Fee is $\$ 10.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Disabled Person (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5e.1, Section 4). One set of plates issued for passenger cars and light trucks regularly operated by or for the transportation of "permanently disabled" persons.

Disabled Person (Motorcycle) (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5e.1, Section 4). One plate issued for a motorcycle regularly operated by or for the transportation of "permanently disabled" persons.


TEXAS EXEMPT


Disabled Vet (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5e). Two plates issued for a passenger car or light truck owned by a veteran of the U.S. Armed Forces who has a service-connected disability of at least 60 percent or at least 40 percent due to amputation of a lower extremity. Plates have a "DV" prefix or suffix with four numbers. Application and $\$ 3.00$ fee must be submitted to Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Disaster Relief (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-3[d]). One plate issued annually to owners of commercial motor vehicles, truck tractors, trailers, and semitrailers used exclusively by nonprofit, disaster relief organizations in emergencies only. Application must be filed with Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Fee - $\$ 5.30$.

Exempt Vehicle (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-3[c]). Plate or plates issued to vehicles owned and used exclusively in the service of the U.S. Government, the State of Texas or any County, City, or School District. Permanent plates issued and remain with vehicle until it ceases to be owned by the exempt agency. Applications approved by Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Exempt Vehicle (Motorcycle) (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-3[c]). One plate issued to motorcycles and mopeds owned and used exclusively in the service of the U.S. Government, the State of Texas or any County, City, or School District. Permanent plates issued and remain with vehicle until it ceases to be owned by the exempt agency. Applications approved by the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Dimensions: $4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$.

Farm Trailer (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-2[c]). One plate issued to owners of farm trailers or semitrailers exceeding 4,000 pounds gross weight but not exceeding 20,000 pounds gross weight that are used for the transportation of the owner's agricultural products, livestock, or farm supplies. Fee - $\$ 5.30$.

Farm Truck (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6a). Two plates issued. Prefix of one number and two letters followed by two or three numbers or suffix of onenumber and two letters preceded by two or three numbers. Fee is $1 / 2$ of regular truck fee.

Farm Truck Tractor (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6a). One plate issued. Plate mounted on front of vehicle. Prefix of letter "T" followed by five numbers. Fee is $1 / 2$ of regular truck tractor fee.

## TEXAS FERTILIZER TRK YR $00 B+000$

 and spread fertilizer. Fee - $\$ 75.30$.Forestry Vehicle (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5p). One plate issued annually to vehicles used exclusively for transporting untreated ties, stave bolts, plywood bolts, pulpwood billets, wood chips, stumps, sawdust, moss, bark, wood shavings, and property used in the production of those products, including logs and debarked logs. Fee is $\$ 2.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Applications approved by the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Former POW (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5g). Two plates issued. Plates have a "PW" prefix followed by three numbers and a one-letter suffix. Issued for persons who were captured and incarcerated by an enemy of the United States during a period of conflict with the United States. Applications must be filed with the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Fee - $\$ 3.00$.

Honorary Consul (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5e.4). Two plates issued annually for passenger cars and light trucks owned by persons who are Honorary Consuls authorized by the United States Government to perform consular duties. Applications must be filed with the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Fees based on the annual registration fee for the vehicle plus $\$ 40.00$.

In Transit (V.A.T.S., Article 6686[b]). One plate issued annually to any person engaged in transporting and delivering, by means of the full mount, saddle mount, tow bar, or any other combination, new vehicles from the manufacturer or any other point of origin to any point of destination within the State. Three to five numbers followed by a one-letter " $V$ " suffix. Applications must be filed with the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Fee for first plate $\$ 50.30$. Additional plates $\$ 5.30$ each.

Korea Veteran(V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to members of the U.S. Armed Forces who were on active duty after June 26, 1950, and before February 1, 1955. Application and $\$ 10.00$ fee (in addition to the regular registration fee) submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Log Loader (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-2[1]). One plate issued to vehicles which have log loading equipment mounted on them and which do not transport logs. Fee is $\$ 62.80$ annually, submitted with the application to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Machinery (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-2[c]). One plate issued to owners of machinery used solely for drilling water wells or construction machinery. Application must be filed with Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Fee - \$5.30.

Manufacturer (V.A.T.S., Article 6686[2]). One plate issued annually to manufacturers located in this state for the purpose of testing their new vehicles which are manufactured or assembled in this state. Fee $-\$ 20.30$.

Marine Corps League (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates available to members of the Marine Corps League or its auxiliary. Fee is $\$ 10.00$ in addition to the regular registration fees prescribed by Iaw. Application and fee submit-. ted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Moped (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-13[h]). One plate issued to certified Mo-. peds. Prefix of one number and two letters followed by two or three numbers. The word "MOPED" appears at bottom of plate. Fee - \$30.30. Dimensions: $4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$.

Motor Bus (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-8a); Two plates issued. Prefix of the letter " $T$ " followed by two to five numbers. Fee based on the gross weight of the vehicle using truck fee schedule.

Motorcycle (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5). One plate issued. Prefix of one number and two letters followed by two or three numbers or suffix of one number and two letters preceded by two or three numbers. Fee $\mathbf{-} \$ 30.30$. Dimensions: $4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$

Parade (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5b). One plate issued to motor vehicles owned and operated by nonprofit organizations and designed and used primarily for parade purposes. One to three numbers followed by "PAR." Applications must be filed with Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. No fee.

Passenger (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5). Two plates issued. Prefix of three letters followed by two numbers and one letter. Fees based on model year or weight of vehicle.

Model year more than six years from date of annual registration $\$ 40.80$

Model year more than three years but six years or less from date of annual registration $\$ 50.80$

Model year three years or less from date of annual registration ........ $\$ 58.80$
For a vehicle over 6,000 pounds, irrespective of model year

Pearl Harbor Survivor (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles owned by persons who were members of the U.S. Armed Forces, and were stationed in the Hawaiian Islands on December 7, 1941, or their unmarried surviving spouses. Fee is $\$ 3.00$, unmarried surviving spouses pay $\$ 3.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Permit License (V.A.T.S., Article 6701d-16, Section 3). One plate issued to commercial vehicles which are used solely for servicing, cleaning out, and for drilling oil wells, provided such vehicles consist. of a mast, an engine for power, a draw works, and a chassis permanently constructed for such purpose. Prefix of two numbers and letter " $P$ " followed by two or three numbers. Application must be filed with Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. If legal vehicle, annual permit required. Special permit required for such vehicle if overweight and/or oversize. Fee - \$5.30.

Personalized License (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5c). Two plates issued provided the number does not conflict with the existing numbering system, does not duplicate another personalized number, or is not objectionable. Applications must be filed with the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Fee based on the annual registration fee for the vehicle plus $\$ 40.00$.

Private Bus (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5[b]). Two plates issued. Prefix of letter "U" followed by three to five numbers. Fee same as passenger car.

Private Nonprofit Organization (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5p). Available to members of Private Nonprofit organizations with a statewide membership of 7,500 or more whose organization has provided the department with a deposit of $\$ 15,000$. Fee is $\$ 25.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee.

Purple Heart Recipient (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles owned by recipients of the Purple Heart medal, or their unmarried surviving spouse. Fee is $\$ 3.00$. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Rental Trailer (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-13). One plate issued to rental trailers having a gross weight not exceeding 4,000 pounds. Plate valid for five years. The owner of rental trailer fleet must file a licensing agreement with the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division in order to qualify for rental trailer plates. Registration fee paid annually. Fee same as trailer.

Soil Conservation(V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-2[h][1]). One plate issued annually for trucks, truck tractors, lowboy trailers, and semitrailers. Prefix of two numbers and letter " $S$ " followed by two or three numbers. Plate can be used only by owners of commercial vehicles transporting their own soil conservation machinery or equipment used in clearing land, terracing, building farm ponds, levees or ditches. Owner may register only one truck or truck tractor and one trailer or semitrailer with this type of plate. Plates nontransferable. Applications must be filed with Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Fee is $1 / 2$ of regular commercial fee.

State Capitol (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles. Fee is $\$ 30.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

State Judge (Minute Order \# 78502). Two plates issued annually. Twoletter prefix of "TX" followed by numbers 10 to 999 . The words STATE JUDGE are embossed on upper portion of plates. Regular fee charged according to classification.

State Official (Minute Order \# 78502). Two plates issued annually to members of Legislature and elected State Officials. Plates remain with owner and may be transferred to a new or different vehicle provided such vehicle is owned by member of Texas Legislature or properly elected official. Regular fee charged according to classification.

State of the Arts (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5m). Two plates issued for passenger and light commercial vehicles. Fee is $\$ 25.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee ( $\$ 20.00$ of each fee goes to support the Texas Commission on the Arts). Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Texas Aerospace Commission (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-51). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles. Fee is $\$ 30.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Texas Guard (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5e.3). Two plates issued. Prefix of one number and letter " $G$ " followed by four numbers. Issued to passenger cars and light trucks only. Application and fee must be filed with Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Regular fee charged according to classification.

Texas Wing Civil Air Patrol (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles owned by members of the Civil Air Patrol. Fee is $\$ 10.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Token Trailer (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6¹/2). One plate issued. One letter prefix or suffix with three to five numbers. Issued only to semitrailers having a gross weight in excess of 6,000 pounds to be pulled by vehicles displaying a Combination License Plate. Fee - $\$ 15.30$.

Token Trailer (Five-Year) (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6½). One plate issued. Prefix of two numbers and one letter followed by two or three numbers. Plates issued for five-year period expiring March 31 , in years ending in " 0 " or " 5 ." The owner of the token trailer fleet must file a licensing agreement with the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division in order to qualify for the five-year token trailer plates. Fee based on token trailer rate and paid for the entire fiveyear period or remainder thereof.

Tow Truck (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5i). One plate issued to tow truck owners registered with the Texas Railroad Commission, in addition to the regular vehicle registration fee. Fee $-\$ 15.00$. Dimensions: $4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$.

Tractor (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-7). One plate issued. Prefix of letter "T" followed by five numbers. Fee is based on weight of tractor.

Trailer (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-8). One plate issued. One letter prefix or suffix with three to five numbers. Issued to all trailers and semitrailers which are not registered with Token Trailer License Plates or Farm Trailer License Plates. Fee based on empty weight plus weight of heaviest load to be carried.

Travel Trailer (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-8). One plate issued for camper trailers and house trailer-type vehicles which are less than 8 feet wide and less than 40 feet long (not including hitch). Fee based on actual weight of vehicle, including all furnishings.

Truck (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6). Two plates issued. Prefix of two letters followed by two to four numbers or suffix of two letters preceded by three to four numbers. Fee based on gross weight of vehicle.
U.S. Air Force (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles owned by active or retired members of the U.S. Air Force. Fee is $\$ 10.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.
U.S. Army (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles owned by active or retired members of the U.S. Army. U.S. Congress (Senate) (Minute Order\#78502). Two plates issued annually to members of the United States Senate. Numbered from Senate 1 to Senate 2. Plates remain with owner and may be transferred to new or different vehicle, provided such vehicle is owned by member of U.S. Senate. Regular fee charged according to classification.
U.S. Judge (Minute Order \# 78502). Two plates issued annually. Threeletter prefix or suffix "USA" and two or three numbers. The words U.S. JUDGE are embossed on upper portion of plates. Regular fee charged according to classification.
U.S. Marine Corps (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to passenger cars and light commercial vehicles owned by active or retired members of the U.S. Marine Corps. Fee is $\$ 10.00$ in addition to the regular registration fee. Application and fee submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Volunteer Firefighter (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5h). Two plates issued for a passenger car or light truck owned by a certified member of a volunteer fire department. Initial application and a $\$ 4.00$ fee must be submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division. Regular fee charged according to classification.

World War II Veteran (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-5k). Two plates issued to members of the U.S. Armed Forces who were on active duty after December 6, 1941, and before January 1, 1947. Application and $\$ 10.00$ fee (in addition to the regular registration fee) submitted to the Vehicle Titles and Registration Division.

Factory Delivery (V.A.T.S., Article 6686[d-1]). One cardboard tag per vehicle valid for 30 days. Issued to new vehicles only. Three to six numbers: followed by a one letter suffix "W." Tags not issued to manufacturers or dealers. Tag cannot be used on vehicle to transport property. Fee is $\$ 3.00$ each.

Mexico 24-Hour Permit (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6c). One cardboard tag valid for 24 hours. Three to six numbers followed by a one letter suffix "M." Fee is $\$ 5.00$.

144-Hour Permit (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6d). One cärdboard tag valid for 144 hours. Three to five numbers followed by a letter and a 4 suffix. Fee is. $\$ 50.00$.

One-Trip Permit (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6e, Section 3). One cardboard tag valid for 15 days. Three to six numbers followed by a one-letter suffix "N." Issued for the temporary movement of an unregistered new or used unladen vehicle. Fee is $\$ 5.00$.

72-Hour Permit (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6d). One cardboard tag valid for: 72 hours. Three to six numbers followed by a one-letter suffix "R," "S," "T,": "U," or "X." Fee is $\$ 25.00$.

30-Day Temporary Registration Permit (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6e, Section 3). One cardboard tag valid for 30 days for use on passenger cars, private buses, trailers and semitrailers not exceeding 10,000 pounds gross weight, or light commercial vehicles not exceeding a one ton manufacturer's rated carrying capacity. Fee - $\$ 25.00$.

30-Day Temporary Registration Permit (Motorcycle) (V.A.T.S., Article 6675a-6e, Section 3). One cardboard tag valid for 30 days for use on motorcycles and mopeds. Fee - \$25.00. Dimensions: $4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$.

Buyer Tag (V.A.T.S., Article 6686). One red on white cardboard tag reflecting assigned dealer number displayed on an unregistered vehicle sold by a dealer. Valid for a period not to exceed 20 days from the date of issuance - may not be reissued.

Charitable Organization Tag (V.A.T.S., Article 6686). One green on white cardboard tag reflecting assigned dealer number displayed on an unregistered vehicle owned by a dealer and loaned to a charitable organization. Valid for a maximum of 30 days from the date of issuance.

Demonstration/Intransit Tag (V.A.T.S., Article 6686). One black on white cardboard tag reflecting assigned dealer number displayed on an unregistered vehicle owned by a dealer and being transported or driven for demonstration purposes only. Valid as long as the vehicle is owned by the dealer.

Note: All dealer issued tags are $6^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$, excepi for those issued to motorcycles and mopeds, which are $4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$.
