

## COUNTY LIBRARIES FOR TEXAS

A COUNTY FREE LIBRARY is the LEGAL RIGHT of EVERY TEXAN.

Your county commissioners' court can provide a county library for you. COUNTY TAXES WILL NOT BE INCREASED. The Texas county library law, passed in 1915, does not permit a special tax for county library support, but does permit the COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT to appropriate, FROM THE TAXES YOU ALREADY PAY, 5 cents on the \$100 of assessed valuation for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a county library.



The COUNTY LIBRARY is the MOST ECONOMICAL and EFFICIENT means of supplying books and reference service to every man, woman and child in the county.

COLLECTIONS of books are placed in the different communities, the number of books being governed by the size of the community.

SUITABLE BOOKS for adults, young people and children are included.

BOOKS WANTED by individuals and clubs will be made available upon request.

NEW BOOKS are added regularly and the collections are exchanged as often as needed.

A CAR FITTED WITH SHELVES is provided, if possible, so that library service can be taken to the schools and smallest communities.

Many other EDUCATIONAL SERVICES are offered by a COUNTY FREE LIBRARY.
