DART Easily to MegaFest Events in June

Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) is the easiest way to attend MegaFest when it returns to the Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center June 28 through July 1. An estimated 100,000 people from across North Texas and the country are expected and a lot of them will ride DART's buses and trains.

Save time and pre-purchase your DART and TRE 3-Day Pass in advance from the free GoPass[™] mobile ticketing application available for both Apple and Android. Individual Local Day passes for DART Rail, bus and passengers riding the TRE between CentrePort and Union Station are \$5. Attendees coming from Tarrant County or Denton County must purchase a Regional Day Pass for \$10. Passes can be purchased on GoPass[™] or at ticket vending machines located at all DART and TRE stations.
