DART into 1999

DART Cotton Bowl Service takes to the field January 1

It seems like old times: former Texas A & M coach Jackie Sherrill is once again taking on [The University of Texas](#) when he brings his [Mississippi State Bulldogs](#) to play in the [Cotton Bowl](#) on New Year's Day.

DART's Cotton Bowl Service will carry passengers from six convenient locations throughout the DART Service Area on New Year's Day. The adult fare is \$7. Children between the ages of five and 11, senior citizens and disabled customers ride for \$6. Parking is free at each park & ride location.

Cotton Bowl Service tickets may be purchased at the park & ride lots the day of the game. Game-day ticket sales at the park & ride lots are cash only.

Buses begin leaving the park & ride locations two hours before game time. The last buses leave the park & ride lots for the stadium about one hour prior to game time. The last bus from the game leaves the Cotton Bowl 30 minutes after the end of the game. Wheelchair lift-equipped buses are available.

 - Red Bird Transit Center (US 67 at Hampton Rd.)
 - South Garland Transit Center (LBJ Service Rd., between Shiloh Rd. & Leon Rd.)
