

## LEGEND

THROCK-SPECK-LUEDERS: Moderately deep to very shallow, undulating to hilly, stony, cobbly, and loamy soils; on uplands

2 LEERAY-SAGERTON-NUKRUM: Deep, nearly level to gently sloping, clayey and loamy soils; on uplands

PEDERNALES-CISCO-HEXT: Deep and moderately deep, gently sloping to undulating, loamy soils; on uplands

4 CHANEY-DEMONA: Deep, gently sloping, sandy soils on uplands

5 FRIO-GAGEBY: Deep, nearly level, loamy soils on flood plains

OPLIN-HEXT-BRACKETT: Very shallow to moderately deep, undulating to hilly, flaggy, loamy, and gravelly soils; on uplands


