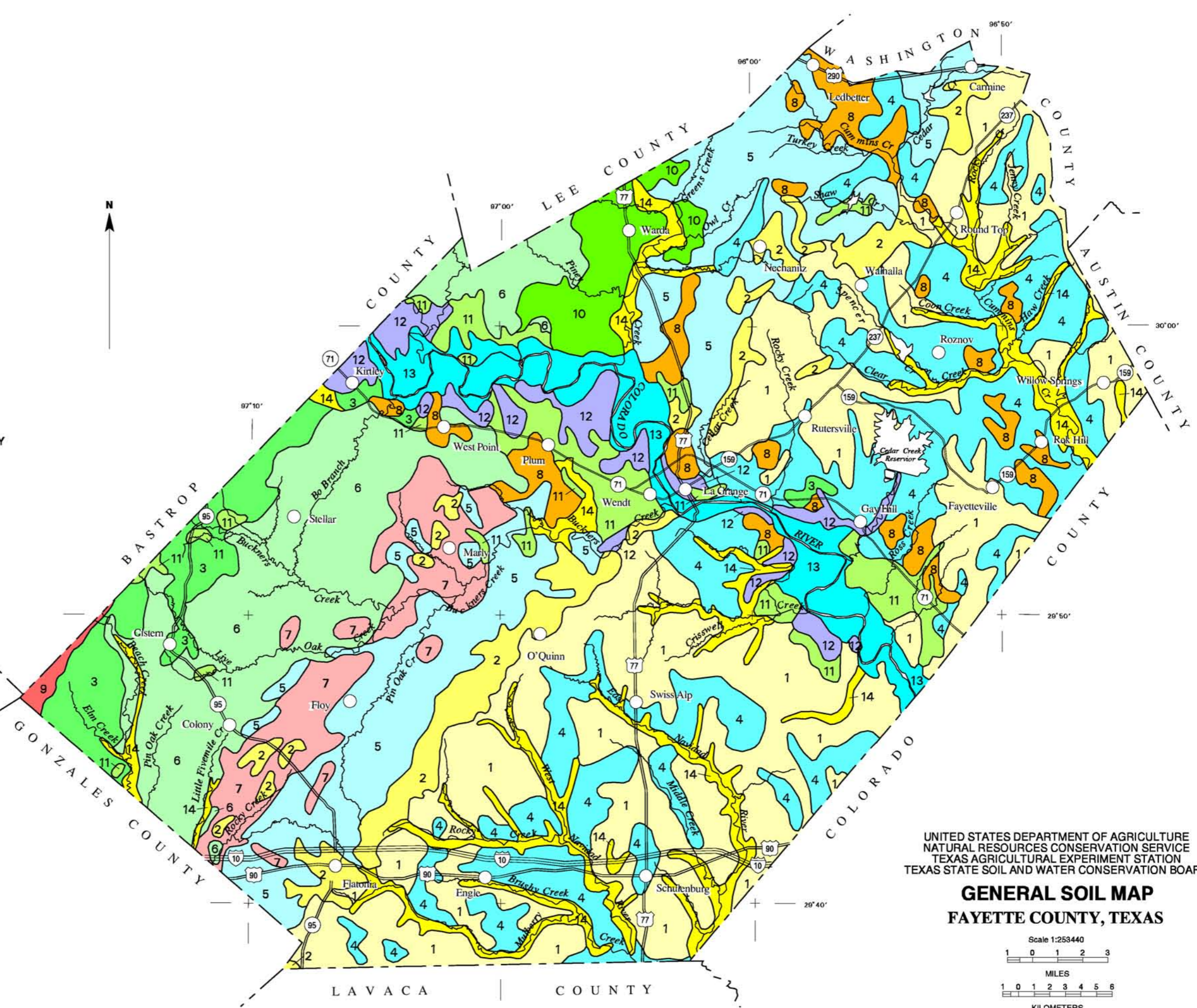
GENTLY SLOPING TO STEEP, LOAMY LOST PINES SOILS ON UPLANDS

NEARLY LEVEL SOILS ON FLOOD PLAINS OF THE COLORADO RIVER AND LOCAL STREAMS

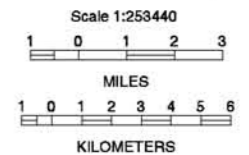
