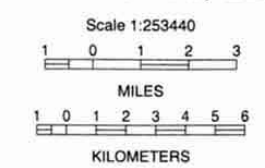
- GENTLY SLOPING TO STEEP SOILS THAT FORMED UNDER DOMINANTLY PINE FORESTS ON UPLANDS
