- 5 SECTION 1. Article 56.01(3), Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 6 amended by Chapters 66 (H.B. 1489) and 268 (S.B. 6), Acts of the
- 7 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, is reenacted and amended
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 (3) "Victim" means a person who is the victim of the
- 10 offense of sexual assault, kidnapping, aggravated robbery,
- 11 trafficking of persons, or injury to a child, elderly individual,
- 12 or disabled individual or who has suffered personal injury or death
- 13 as a result of the criminal conduct of another.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
