3 classification of the water affected by discharges from the

5 (3) the expenses necessary to obtain and administer
6 the NPDES program;

7 (4) the reasonable costs of administering the water
8 quality management programs under Section 26.0135; and

9 (5) any other reasonable costs necessary to administer
10 and enforce a water resource management program reasonably related
11 to the activities of the persons required to pay a fee under this
12 section.

13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
