

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the place for the convening of a county convention.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 174.062, Election Code, is amended by
5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
6 follows:

7 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (c), a [A] county
8 convention shall be held in a county if the county is not situated
9 in more than one state senatorial district.

10 (c) If the county executive committee for a political party
11 determines that no suitable location for the county convention is
12 available in the county, the county executive committee may apply
13 to the state executive committee of that political party to issue an
14 order permitting the county convention to be held at a location
15 outside the county. An order under this subsection must be entered
16 in the minutes of the state executive committee not later than the
17 30th day before the date the county convention is to be held.

18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
