20	(b) The members [commission shall appoint members of the

22	appointed by the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the speaker
23	of the house of representatives, who shall each appoint [include]:
24	(1) <u>one member [four members</u>] who <u>represents</u>

- 9 (c) A member serves at the pleasure of the officer who

- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to the public
- 15 transportation advisory committee does not affect the entitlement
- 16 of a member serving on the committee immediately before the
- 17 effective date of this Act to serve the remainder of the member's
- 18 term. The first two members whose positions expire or become vacant
- 19 may not be replaced.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
