- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1704.052, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1704.052. DISCRETIONARY CREATION OF BOARD. A board
- 8 may be created in a county with a population of less than 110,000
- 9 if<u>:</u>
- 10 <u>(1)</u> a majority of the persons who would serve as
- 11 members of the board under Section 1704.053, or who would designate
- 12 the persons who would serve as members of the board, determine to
- 13 create a board; and
- 14 (2) the commissioners court approves the creation of
- 15 the board by a majority vote.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
