REGULATION OF FOOD HANDLERS AND OTHER FOOD SERVICE EMPLOYEES BY COUNTIES, PUBLIC HEALTH DISTRICTS, AND THE 7 DEPARTMENT. (a) A county, a public health district, or the 8 department may require certification under Subchapter D, Chapter 9 438, for each food handler who is employed by a food service 10 establishment in which food is prepared on-site for sale to the 11 public and which holds a permit issued by the county, the public 12 health district, or the department. This section applies without 13 regard to whether the food service establishment is at a fixed 14 location or is a mobile food unit. 15 (b) The requirements of certification under this section 16 may not be more stringent than the requirements of Subchapter D, 17 18 Chapter 438.
