(a) Notwithstanding 8 9 Subchapter I, Chapter 51, or any other law, the court of criminal 10 appeals may adopt rules and procedures providing for and governing 11 the electronic filing of briefs, pleadings, and other documents for 12 capital cases in that court. 13 (b) In the adoption of rules and procedures under Subsection 14 (a), the court of criminal appeals shall coordinate with the

supreme court and the rules and procedures adopted by that court.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
