4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 161, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 161.01035 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 161.01035. PROVIDER CHOICE SYSTEM. (a) The
8	department shall implement a provider choice system for the
9	vaccines for children program operated by the department under
10	authority of 42 U.S.C. Section 1396s and the adult safety net
11	vaccination program.
12	(b) The department shall ensure that eligible health care
13	providers participating in the vaccines for children program or the
14	adult safety net vaccination program may select any licensed
15	vaccine, including combination vaccines and any dosage forms that:
16	(1) are recommended by the federal Advisory Committee
17	on Immunization Practices;
18	(2) are made available to the department by the
19	Centers for Disease Control and Prevention of the United States
20	Public Health Service; and
21	(3) for adult vaccines, are on the department-approved
22	list of vaccines offered by the adult safety net vaccination
23	program.
24	(c) For the purposes of this section, "equivalent vaccines"

- 1 means two or more vaccines, excluding the influenza vaccine, that
- meet all of the following: 2
- 3 (1) protect a recipient of a vaccine against the same
- 4 infection or infections;
- 5 (2) require the same number of doses;
- 6 have similar safety and efficacy profiles; and
- 7 (4) are recommended for comparable populations by the
- 8 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention of the United States
- 9 Public Health Service.
- 10 (d) The department shall provide a vaccine selected by a
- 11 health care provider under Subsection (b) only if the cost to the
- department of providing the vaccine is not more than 115 percent of 12
- 13 the lowest-priced equivalent vaccine.
- 14 (e) This section does not apply in the event of a disaster or
- public health emergency, terrorist attack, hostile military or 15
- paramilitary action, or extraordinary law enforcement emergency. 16
- (f) The department shall convene the immunization work 17
- group established under Section 161.0095 and solicit its 18
- 19 recommendations regarding development of a plan for the
- implementation of the provider choice system under this section. 20

- The plan shall include the education of participating health care
- 22 providers about:
- 23 (1) procedures and distribution systems of the Centers
- 24 for Disease Control and Prevention of the United States Public
- 25 Health Service; and
- 26 (2) vaccine options, the enrollment process,
- 27 ordering, accountability, and reporting procedures.

- 1 SECTION 2. Effective September 1, 2010, Section 161.0103,
- 2 Health and Safety Code, is repealed.
- 3 SECTION 3. The Department of State Health Services shall
- 4 implement all or part of the provider choice system under Section
- 5 161.01035, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, as soon as
- 6 it is determined to be feasible, provided, however, that the
- 7 department shall complete implementation of the system not later
- 8 than August 31, 2010.
- 9 SECTION 4. Except as provided by this Act, this Act takes
- 10 effect September 1, 2009.
