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1 (F) an independent review organization from 2 disclosing confidential patient information, except to a provider 3 who is under contract to perform the review; and 4 (2) require: 5 (A) an independent review organization to be 6 based and certified in this state and to locate the organization's 7 primary offices in this state; 8 (B) an independent review organization to voluntarily surrender the organization's certification while the 9 10 organization is under investigation or as part of an agreed order; and 11 12 (C) an independent review organization to apply 13 for and receive a new certification after the organization is sold 14 to a new owner.
