

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the compensation of a member of the board of directors
3 of the Bexar-Medina-Atascosa Counties Water Control and
4 Improvement District No. 1.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 9007, Special District
7 Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 9007.055 to read as
8 follows:

9 Sec. 9007.055. COMPENSATION. Notwithstanding Section
10 49.060(a), Water Code, a director is not entitled to receive a fee
11 of more than \$150 a month for performing the duties of a director.

12 SECTION 2. Section 9007.055, Special District Local Laws
13 Code, as added by this Act, applies only to the compensation of a
14 member of the board of directors of the Bexar-Medina-Atascosa
15 Counties Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 for
16 performing the duties of a director on or after the effective date
17 of this Act. Compensation for performing the duties of a director
18 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
19 effect when the duties were performed, and the former law is
20 continued in effect for that purpose.

21 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
22 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
23 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
24 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,

1 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
2 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
3 Government Code.

4 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
5 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
6 Environmental Quality.

7 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
8 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
9 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
10 representatives within the required time.

11 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
12 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
13 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
14 and accomplished.

15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
19 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
