- 13 <u>district shall be considered an original district and a reference</u>

- (b) On petition of any district landowner or on a motion by
- 17 the district's board of directors, the board may consider a
- 18 proposal to divide the district.
- (c) No division of the district may occur that would result
- 20 in the creation of a new district that contains land outside of the
- 21 boundaries of the district as it existed on January 1, 2009.
- 22 (d) Section 54.016, Water Code, and Section 42.042, Local
- 23 Government Code, do not apply to any new district created by the
- 24 division of the district.

- 1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2009.
